### RESOLUTION OF PROJECT CLOSING STATEMENT FOR THE CONIFER BALL FIELDS

**WHEREAS**, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders has approved an Open Space Trust Fund and established a Municipal Open Space Program to provide Program Grant funds in connection with municipal acquisition of lands for County park, recreation, conservation and farmland preservation purposes, as well as for County recreation and conservation development and maintenance purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Middletown entered into a Municipal Open Space Program Grant Agreement with the County of Monmouth on January 28, 2010 that provided \$250,000 for the development of the Conifer Tract Baseball Fields under Application No. 09-23 that required certain conditions be met by the Township of Middletown prior to receipt of the aforesaid funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monmouth County Park System requires a certified copy of a resolution of the governing body determining that the project aforesaid was finally complete and a closing statement of "Final Change Order" adopted by the governing body.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of Township of Middletown that all conditions of the on January 28, 2010 Grant Agreement have been satisfied by the Township of Middletown and that the project has been completed; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Township of Middletown made final payment to the contractor, Precise Construction, Inc., for all work specified in the original contract (less 2% retainage) per the payment request approved by Township Engineer Joseph E. Maloney, P.E. on July 8, 2013, that said payment was authorized by Township Committee via resolution on July 15, 2013, and that said documents are hereby attached and also on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN OF PROPERTY LOCATED BLOCK 795, LOT 17.05, COMMONLY KNOWN AS 68 IRONWOOD COURT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRESERVING IT AS AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING UNIT

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Fair Housing Act, the Township of Middletown (the "Township") has adopted a Housing Element and Fair Share Plan (the "Plan") for the administration of affordable housing units within its borders to protect the Township from builder's remedy litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to purchase an affordable housing unit located at Block 795, Lot 17.05 on the official Tax Map of the Township, commonly known as 68 Ironwood Court, Middletown, New Jersey (the "Unit") from Kristi Lee Freibott for the COAH specified price of \$113,559.00 so as to retain the Unit as part of its Affordable Housing Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Township's Director of Planning and Township Administrator to purchase the Unit for the COAH specified price of \$113,559.00 in order to preserve the Unit as affordable housing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that as the Affordable Housing Authority in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:27D-325 is authorized to contract and take all necessary actions required to purchase the affordable housing unit located at Block 795, Lot 17.05 on the official Tax Map of the Township, commonly known as 68 Ironwood Court, Middletown, New Jersey from Kristie Lee Freibott at the COAH specified price of \$113,559.00 so as to retain the Unit as part of its Affordable Housing Plan subject to available funds from the Affordable Housing Special Trust.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor, Township Clerk and Township Attorney are authorized to execute the appropriate contract and all documents necessary to effectuate the acquisition of the affordable housing unit as set forth herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that if any sentence, paragraph or section of this resolution, or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or if by legislative action an sentence, paragraph or section of this resolution shall lose its force and effect, such judgment or action shall not affect, impair or void the remainder of this resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage according to law.

WHEREAS, applications have been made to the Middletown Township Committee for PLENARY RETAIL DISTRIBUTION LICENSE for the year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014 accompanied by the statutory fee of \$1,382.00.
